**Application:**

1. Method and scope: MT & ET for welds in Structure and piping
2. Level III duties (i.e. direct involvement in review and approval of NDT reports, NDT procedures, calibration of NDT equipment & tools, performance check & evaluation and etc.) shall be active where NDT is being performed and executed check including regular crosscheck shall be documented.
3. NDT shall be carried out according to approved NDT procedures based on latest DNVGL-CG-0051 and applicable standards (e.g. DNV GL-OS-C401, D101, E101).
4. NDT shall be carried out by operators whose name were on the list of NDT personnel endorsed by DNV GL.
5. The list of NDT personnel shall be maintained.
6. DNV GL may initiate random audit if deemed necessary, either as part of the approval process or as the result of findings during a project. The audit may be either a review of documentation or a verification of processes.
7. At least 3 months before the period of validity expires, the supplier shall apply to DNV GL for renewal of the Certificate of Approval.
8. Renewal of the certificate shall be made at intervals not exceeding three (3) years by verification through audits that approved conditions are being maintained
9. The approval is not interchangeable
